Though superseded by the Book of Common Worship, this Supplemental Liturgical Resource remains valuable, both for the variety of liturgical texts it contains and for the commentary on the text, which contains rich historical, theological, and practical background. Specifically, this Supplemental Liturgical Resource volume contains services of baptism and several settings for services of the renewal of baptism.

**251.21 Preaching Without Notes** By Joseph M. Webb This book outlines how to prepare sermons with a very simple technique. There are no short cuts or tricks; it simply approaches sermon preparation from a different angle. The main thesis of the book is don't use written notes when delivering your sermon. Dr. Webb explains that communication is better with people when you are looking at them. Since you won't be using written notes in the pulpit, you need to deliver a different kind of sermon. There shouldn't be a complicated outline or a manuscript with finely crafted paragraphs. Instead you will simply talk with

your congregation, relating a series of stories, events, and ideas. Preparing a sermon that you can remember is a wonderfully liberating experience. 134 pages.

Part 2 History and Tradition “How did we get to be this way?”

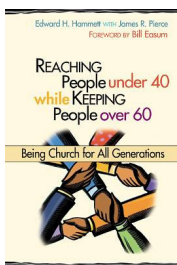
Part 3 Belief and Doctrine “What do we believe?”
