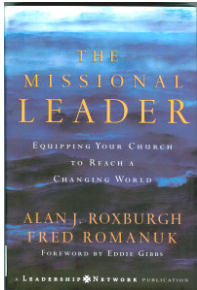

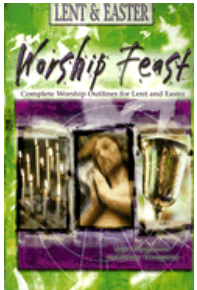
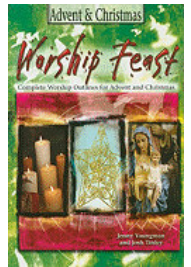


### **266.22Rox The Missional Leader: Equipping Your Church to Reach A Changing**
